PLAYROOM



- Throw out broken, incomplete and inexpensive toys that are low quality *unless extremely loved*
 - CHILDREN ARE HAPPIER, MORE CREATIVE AND PLAY BETTER WITH LESS TOYS
- Create boundaries
 - Categorize toys by type (Cars, blocks, dolls, etc.)
 - · Ensure your storage solutions accommodate your categories
 - ADD CONTAINERS, COLOR, LABELING AND ZONES
 TO PROMOTE CREATIVITY AND RESPONSIBILITY
- Decide what toys to keep
 - · Teach your kids to edit the amount in each category
 - Create a game that helps them identify their favorite toys (This or That) (Toy Memory)
 - NOTHING SHOULD BE STORED ON THE FLOOR
- Box up remaining toys
 - Anything that doesn't fit into the designated category storage should be donated or stored for "toy rotation"
 - AFTER YOUR KIDS HAVE ENJOYED THE TOYS, LET SOMEONE ELSE
